An employee tenders their resignation today, giving 1 day's notice. Their last day of work will be today, as the notice period includes the day when the employee served notice. Scenario 2 – 1 month's notice (with public holidays) An employee gives 1 month's notice.

## **Termination with notice**

Notice periods are often a key part of your contract and can range from a few weeks to a few months. If this isn't the case, and you aren't given a formal notice period, then standard practice is two weeks or more – it's better if you can give your boss a bit of time to prepare for your departure.

It is best to use the Form N9. But if you write a notice yourself, the notice must include: the address of the place you are moving out of, the date you are moving, your signature, and; the date you signed the notice. You do not need to give a reason why you are moving.
