Press the clutch all the way to the floor board with your left foot (the gear shifter must be in the neutral position). Turn the ignition key. If you are certain that the car is in neutral, you can remove your foot from the clutch. Ensure that the parking or emergency brake is not in use.

Press on the accelerator gently to smoothly increase the vehicle's speed. When the engine is in gear, to increase your speed smoothly, continue to apply pressure with your right foot to the accelerator pedal. Continue to press until the RPMs get to the 2500 range on your dashboard display.

Each gear has a top speed, with gear 1 having the lowest top speed and gear 5 or 6 having the highest top speed. Adjust the throttle lever to fine tune the speed within the gear you have selected.
