Three new species are added to the roster of Arkansas' tree flora: Pignut hickory, *Carya glabra*, is one of the most common hickories in the Southeastern forests east of the Mississippi River, and probably the most poorly understood hickory species as well, with such a range of variability that botanists are uncertain whether the taxon comprises a single extremely variable species or a number of weak, closely related segregate species.
