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Manual Exposure Blending

While HDR (automatic blending of multiple exposures) could be used here, I strongly prefer to use a manual approach to blend the exposures with luminosity masking techniques in Photoshop. While I do use HDR for some other situations, I find that HDR tends to create a lot of halos when I have large areas of light and dark, such as in this image.

Exposure Fusion is where you combine a number of bracketed images with an automatic algorithm built into software such as Photomatrix, Lightroom/Enfuse or other similar applications. Exposure blending is where you combine several bracketed images manually with layers in Photoshop. Since the images are on different Photoshop layers you have exacting control of how the layers are blended together.

This can be simply done with the following script. In Photoshop, select: File/Scripts/Load files into stacks (if you use Lightroom just select both thumbnails, right click and choose "Edit in->Open as Layers in PS). Then select your two exposure files. Label the layers for identification.

Multiple Exposure Blending is the other option for creating high dynamic range images. It is done by hand-blending two or more images via layers. Then, you brush on masks in Photoshop to show or hide certain parts. I do almost all of my landscape photographs with some combination of GND filters and MEB techniques.

How To Blend Exposures With Luminosity Masks In Photoshop ...

The basic technique is to create a layer above the image that contains the other exposure of the same scene. Finally, we apply a layer mask to the this layer which makes parts of the image transparent that we want to show through from below. Step 1 ¶ Here are the two exposures, loaded into GIMP.

Exposure Blending HDR Use the HDR (High Dynamic Range) function to assemble multiple photos with varying exposure ranges into a single picture. This is sometimes called "sandwiching." This function helps solve the problem of the limited dynamic range of camera sensors.

26 One classic technique that digital cameras make very easy is blending more than one exposure together for contrast control, increased dynamic range, or creative purposes. A variation on this technique is to apply different RAW-conversion settings to a single RAW file and then combine the files into a single image.

Here is another composite of the same scene captured on a different day using the same blending technique: ILCE-7M2 + FE 24-70mm F4 ZA OSS @ 70mm, ISO 100, 1/6, f/5.6. If you have never tried blending images like this, give it a try - it is a great technique and it really works, particularly for cityscapes.

How to Blend Multiple Exposures of Cityscapes

Mixing silhouettes and textures is an effective way of creating bold double exposure images. One of the easiest ways to get results with double exposures is to overlay a texture onto a recognizable shape. Silhouettes of people work great for this.
